



Free Baby Blanket Crochet Patterns

This is a simple crochet baby blanket. I like that there are no obvious rows or lines as happens with single or double crochet. Switching them up in this pattern blurs the lines and produces a lovely thick fabric with a wonderful drape.

My sample blanket is 30 inches square. You could make yours a bit longer -- around 34 inches long -- if you prefer.

Skill Level: Beginner – Easy

USA Format

Seed stitch

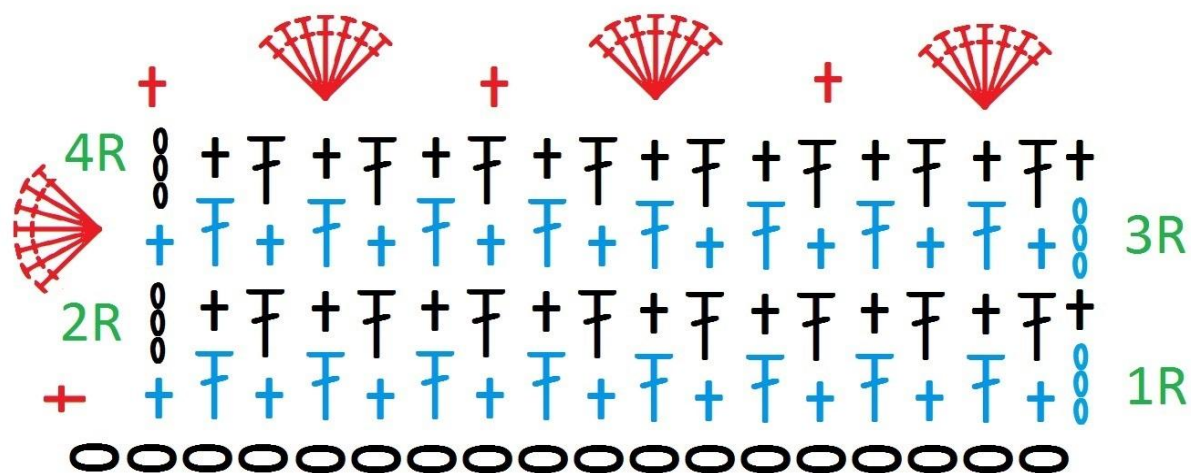
Row 1:

Ch an odd number of sts, sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, [sc in next ch, dc in next ch] across, turn.

Row 2:

Ch 1, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, [sc in next dc, dc in next sc] across, turn.

Rep row 2 for pattern.



Abbreviations

ch. Chain

sl st. Slip Stitch

sc. Single Crochet

dc. Double Crochet

rpt. Repeat
